How to calculate Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

- Students' grade-point averages are numerical values obtained by dividing the total grade points earned by the credits attempted.
- Only courses' graded A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, and F are used to determine credits attempted.

Letter Grade	Grade Point	Course Credit	Point
Α	4.0	3.0	4.0 *3.0 = 12.0
A-	3.7	3.0	3.7*3.0 = 11.1
B+	3.3	2.0	3.3*2.0 = 6.6

Total point earned: 12.0 + 11.1 + 6.6 = 29.7

Total credit completed: 3 + 3 + 2 = 8.0

Grade Point Average (GPA) is 29.7/8.0 = 3.71
